- Students **learn** about American Indian food and shelter.
- Students **wear and experience** deerskin and coyote-hide clothing.
- Students **inspect & analyze** arrowheads, arrows, wampum, and turtle rattles
- Students **role play** an American Indian ceremony.
- Students **play with** American Indian toys and games.
- Students **compare** Algonquian life on Long Island long ago to the American Indian culture of today.

Presentations range in length from 40 minutes to one hour, depending upon the needs of the teacher. Our educators teach classroom groups of 25-30 students, with a maximum of four classes per day. Fees are \$200 for the first class, and \$100 for each additional class. **All programs are BOCES approved.**
