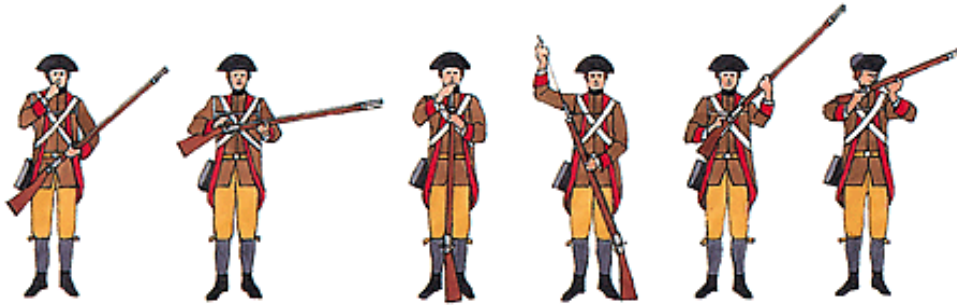


Long Island and New York During the American Revolution

A Three Village Historical Society In-School Presentation for Students



- Students **demonstrate** reloading a Brown Bess musket.
- Students **examine** a real powder horn and replicas of musket balls
- Students **understand** why George Washington lost the Battle of Long Island.
- Students **interpret** life on Long Island under British occupation.
- Students **learn** about messages written in invisible ink and **examine** a quill pen.
- Students **use** a “**mask**” to reveal a hidden message.
- Students **decode** letters written by George Washington’s Culper Spy Ring.

Presentations range in length from 40 minutes to one hour, depending upon the needs of the teacher. Our educators teach classroom groups of 25-30 students, with a maximum of four classes per day.
