The Awards that are presented each year are:

The Robert Cushman Murphy Memorial Award-In recognition of significant contributions to the preservation and conservation of our natural environment and to the fostering of a personal identification with the natural heritage of the Three Villages.

Ward Melville Community Award – In appreciation of valuable contributions to the advancement of the quality of life in the Three Villages and the fostering of pride in the rich historical heritage of our homes and lands.

Kate Wheeler Strong Memorial Award – In recognition of significant contributions toward the fostering of interest in local history and a fuller appreciation of the rich historical and cultural heritage of this community.

Maggie Gillie Memorial Award – For contributions by a member of the Society in recognition of overall dedicated service, and for significant contributions to furthering the goals of the Society.

Gayle Becher Memorial Award – In recognition of volunteer efforts during the past year to help the Society by performing those necessary tasks that facilitate its efficient operation. The Gayle Becher Memorial Award honors volunteers whose work consists of loyal support repeated on a regular basis.

Three Village Historical Society Young Historian Award – For outstanding contribution to the Society by a young person.

Three **Community Award Certificates** are also given out for:

Enhancing or restoring a building to be used as a commercial structure in a way that contributed to the historic beauty of the area.

For a house restoration or renovation and on-going maintenance and preservation in keeping with the original architectural design.

For ornamental planting or landscaping that enhances the beauty of the Three Village area.
